Through Congress and Inter-Congress meetings, and ongoing scientific Working Groups, PSA provides an interdisciplinary platform for scientists to discuss research findings and their relevance to the region. The broad sub-themes of the meeting are:

- Culture and Gender;
- Governance, Economic Development and Public Policy; and
